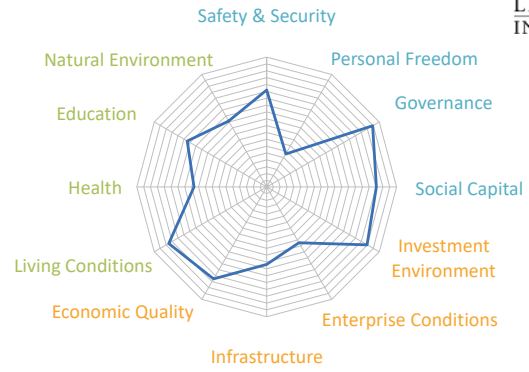
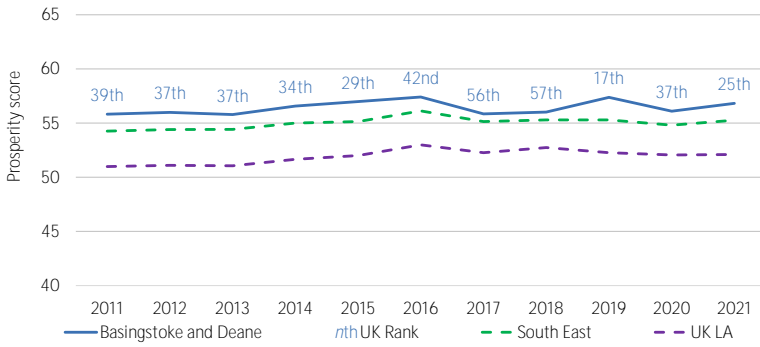


Basingstoke and Deane: Prosperity score 56.8 (25th)
