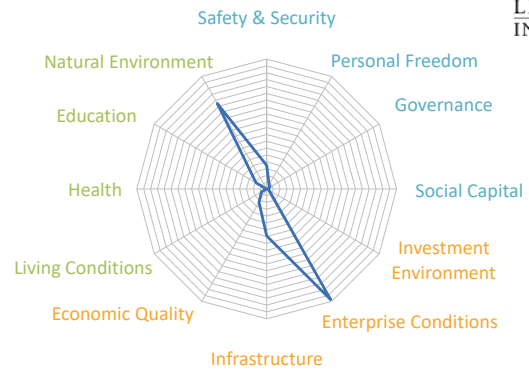
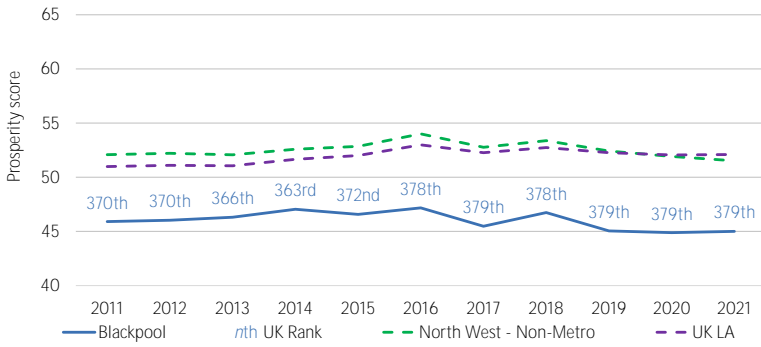


Blackpool: Prosperity score 45.0 (379th)
