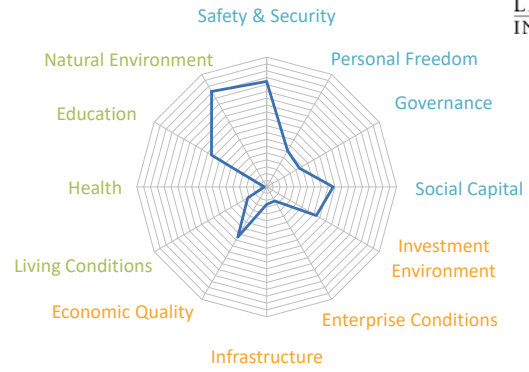
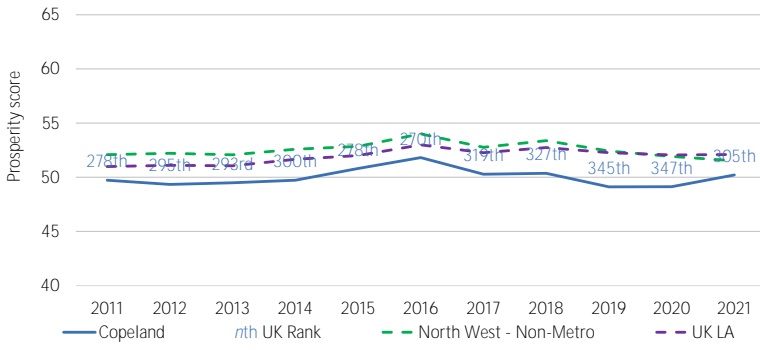


Copeland: Prosperity score 50.2 (305th)
