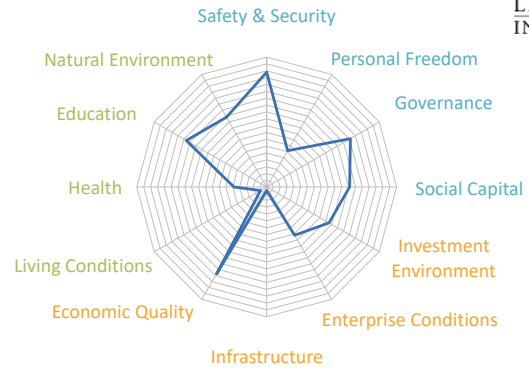
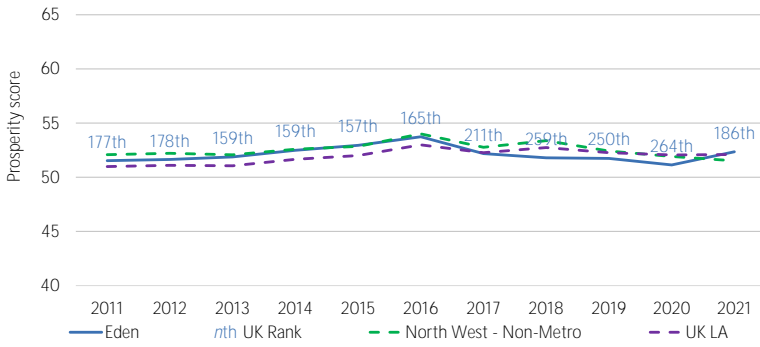


Eden: Prosperity score 52.3 (186th)
