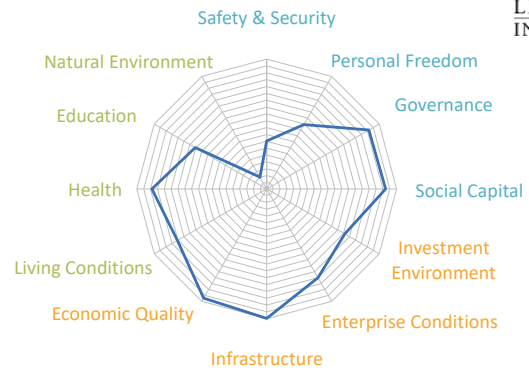
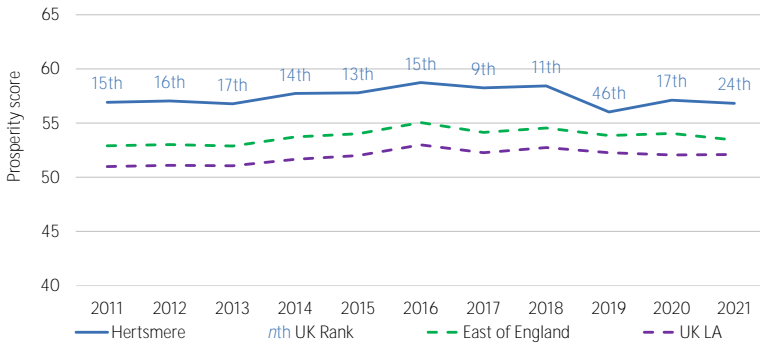


Hertsmere: Prosperity score 56.8 (24th)
