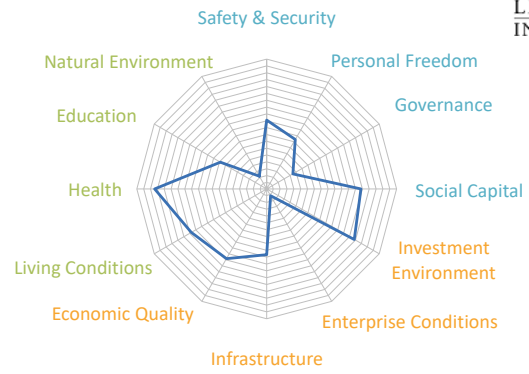
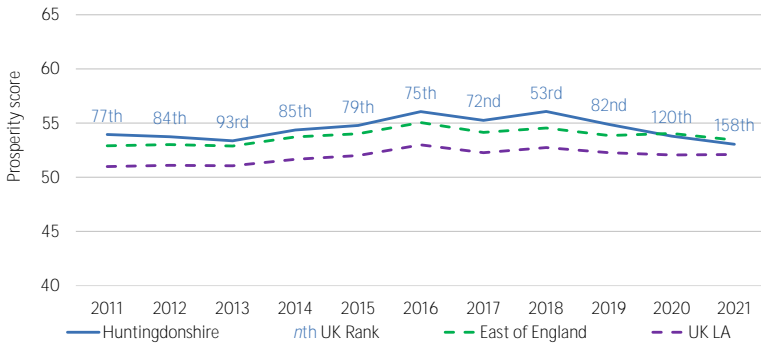


Huntingdonshire: Prosperity score 53.0 (158th)
