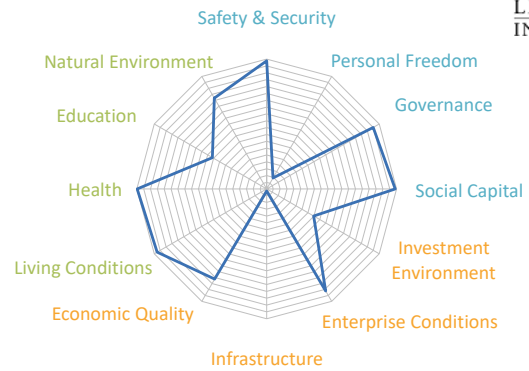
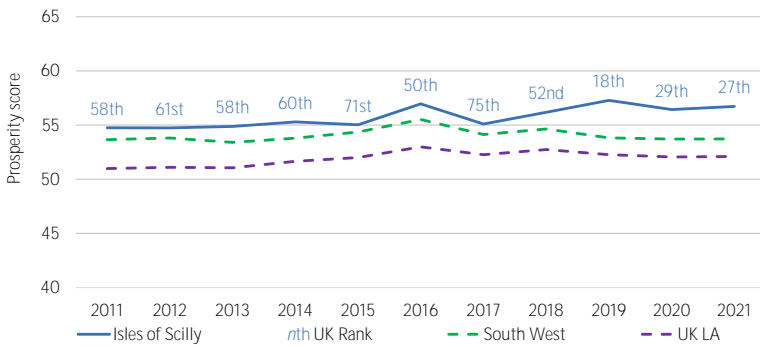


Isles of Scilly: Prosperity score 56.7 (27th)
