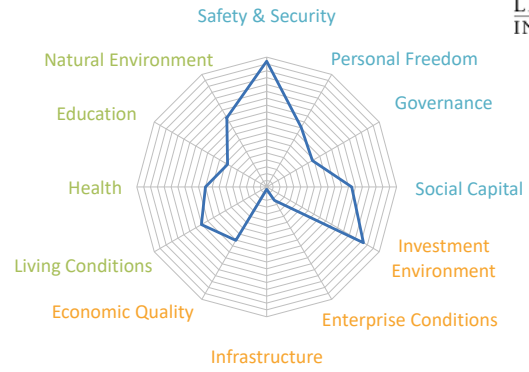
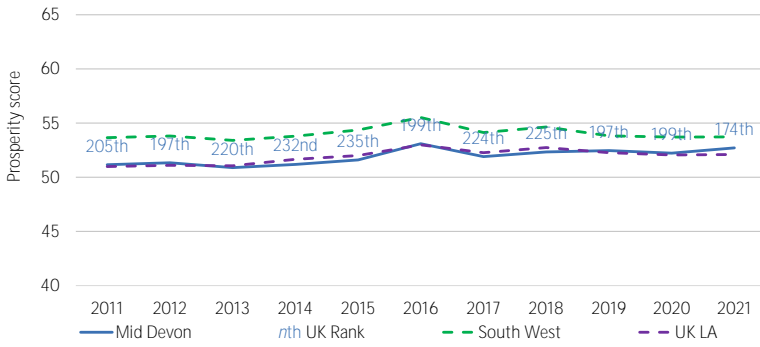





































Prosperity over time

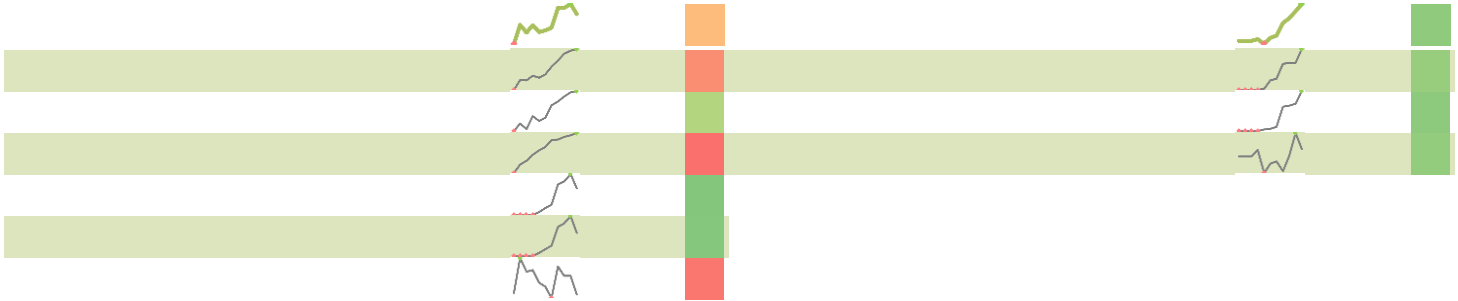
