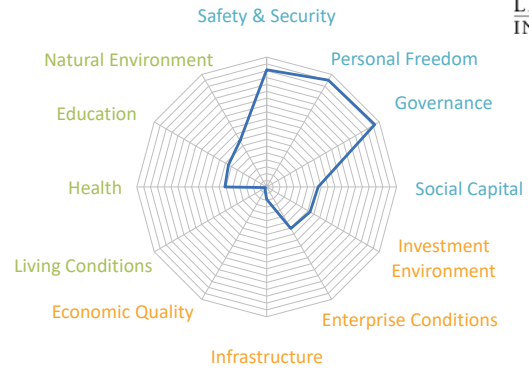
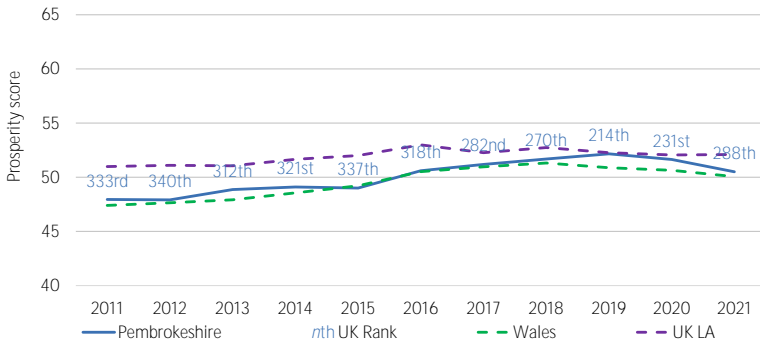


Pembrokeshire: Prosperity score 50.5 (288th)
