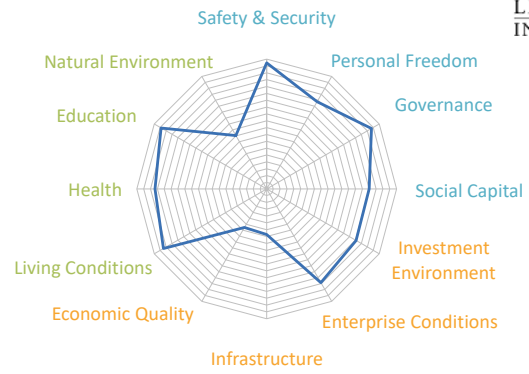
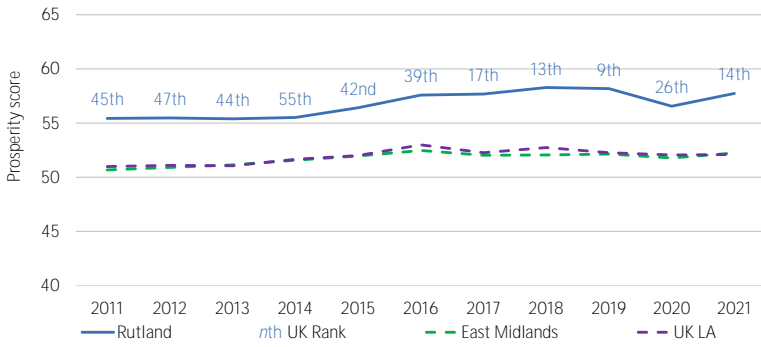


Rutland: Prosperity score 57.7 (14th)
