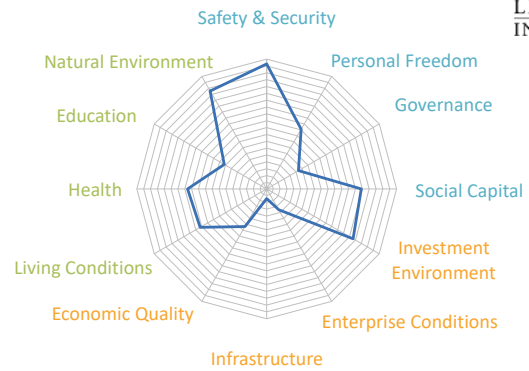
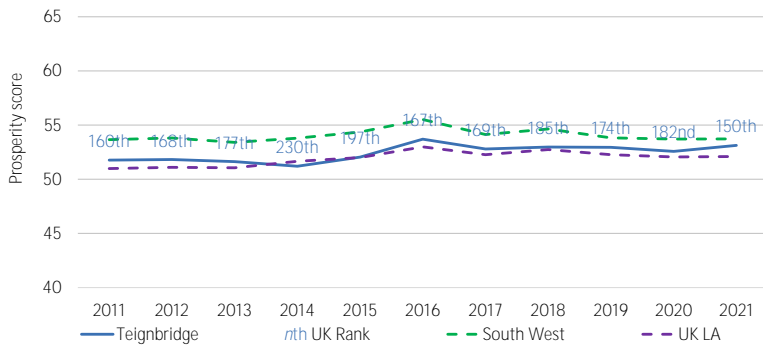


Teignbridge: Prosperity score 53.1 (150th)
