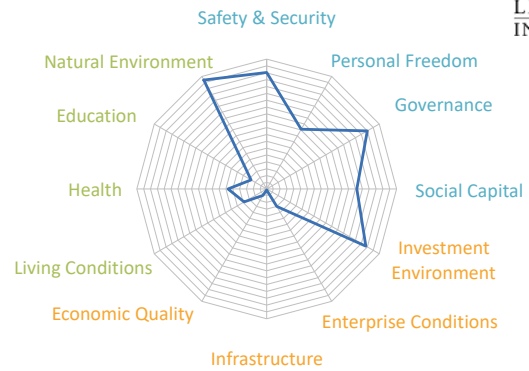
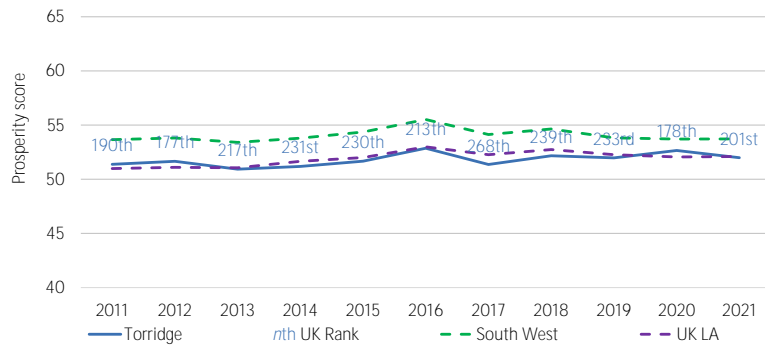


Torridge: Prosperity score 52.0 (201st)
