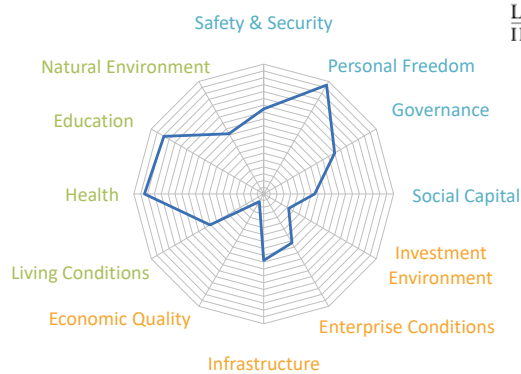
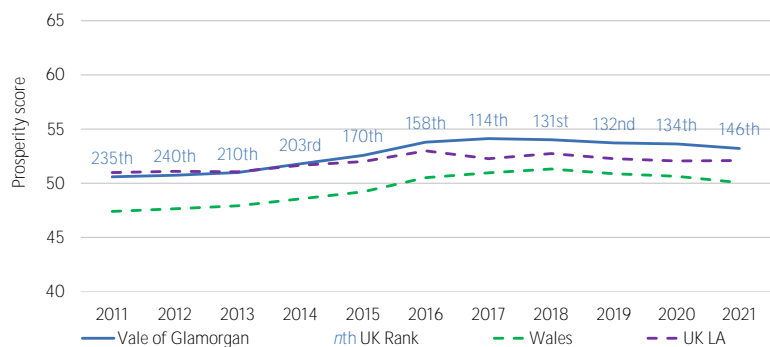


Vale of Glamorgan: Prosperity score 53.2 (146th)
