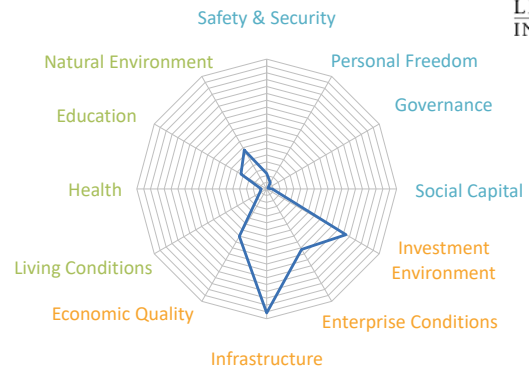
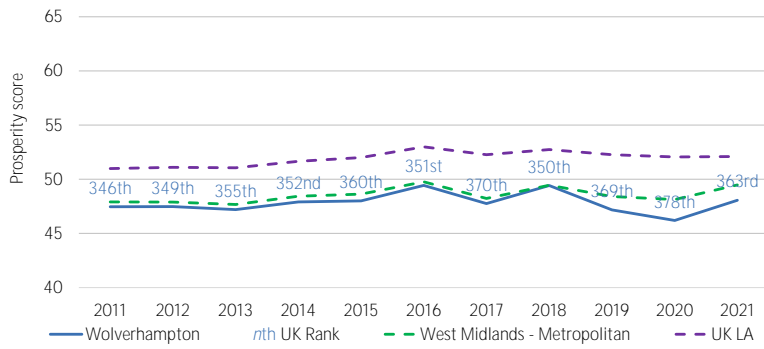


Wolverhampton: Prosperity score 48.1 (363rd)













































